

A Day at Open Door

A Program of the Coalition for Compassion and Justice

On a recent day at CCJ Open Door we served 185 guests representing a total of 356 members in their households. Of that total, 72 were children, 15 were seniors and 42 were veterans. Of the total 59 were homeless. There were 106 families who received groceries from our pantry and another 20 who received government commodities. A total of 78 households received clothing, while 4 were given diapers for babies. Ten people took showers, eight were given toiletries and ten others took advantage of mail and message service. There are many ways that CCJ Open Door makes life better for low-income residents, and with the current economy, there is definitely a growing need.

Open Door is continually in need of food for hot meals and food boxes, paper plates, bowls and cups, clothing, small household items like towels and bed linens, diapers, toiletries, cleaning products and financial donations.
