REPORTS of Committees

Treasurer Brian De Vries stated that April income was below budget. Brian requested we obtain an auditor to audit the books, and establish a finance committee.

Trustees: Scott Peterson reported that a list of first quarter recipients is available. Scott reported for David Cross that he has information regarding the financial needs for repairs to infrastructure and capital funding.
