



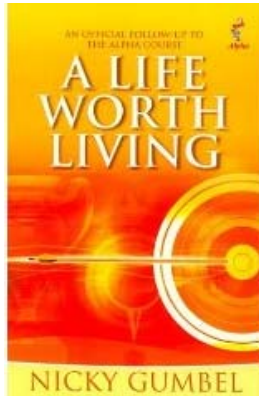

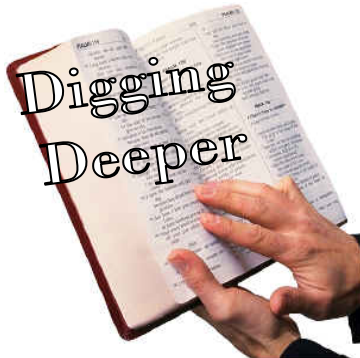

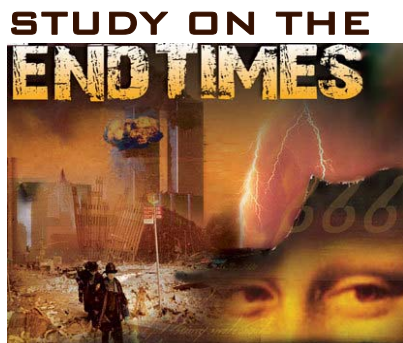

This class will focus in on a biblical view of creation and how to answer those tough questions that your children ask. It will also teach parents how to defend their faith and belief given a biblical worldview

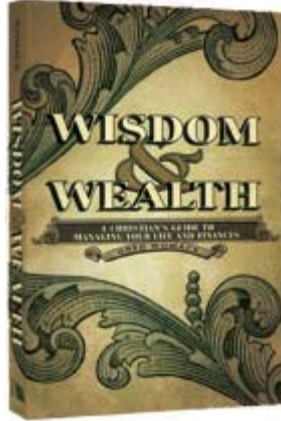

Study on the End Times

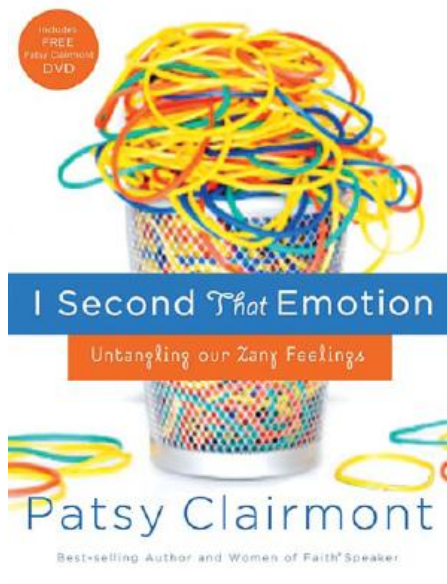

Wisdom and Wealth

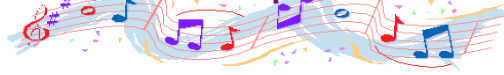
