Your Church Council is seeking talented and dedicated individuals for two vacant positions. The responsibilities for both positions are outlined below. COUNCIL COORDINATOR OF MEMBERSHIP GROWTH AND SUPPORT shall:

- Endeavor to create a welcoming and loving atmosphere for all visitors and new members. Visitors will be personally greeted at the time of their visit(s) by trained Church members.
- Ensure that all pertinent personal information is collected from visitors with an expeditious and personal follow-up to acknowledge their visit, providing written information and a verbal overview of the Congregation, while seeking to understand and facilitate their needs.
- Make every effort to see that all congregation members are utilized in the workings of the Congregation according to their God-given skills and talents, beginning with new members.
- Strive to make sure that every person who attends AELC is loved, treated with the respect that Christ has directed through His Word, and assisted in the worshipping and learning of the scriptures, as well as ministered to in their hour of need.
- Annually review existing ministry charters with the Membership Growth and Support Advisory Committee to see if they conform to the strategic plan.
- Recommend to Church Council the establishment of new ministries.
- Review the Associate Membership list annually, with the Senior Pastor's help, and file a report with the council in time for the annual congregational report. (See B2.04.b of the bylaws.)

COUNCIL COORDINATOR OF YOUTH MINISTRIES shall:

- Work with the Youth Ministries Advisory Committee comprised of parents, youth leaders, and at least one representative youth member.
- Meet with the Associate Pastor and the Youth Director regularly to ensure that the youth's needs are being addressed and provide Church Council with a report regarding the youth's activities.
- Work with the Associate Pastor and Youth Director to vet all volunteers who work directly with the youth to provide a safe and healthy environment.
- Work with the Youth Ministries Advisory Committee to create a list of all youth activities, to be submitted to the Church Council annually. This list should demonstrate that youth activities are a balance of engaging fellowship, solid Christian education, and growth in both stewardship and service.
- Meet with the Council Coordinator of Adult Education and Children's and Family Ministries periodically to plan intergenerational activities.
