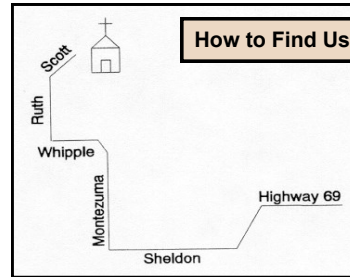

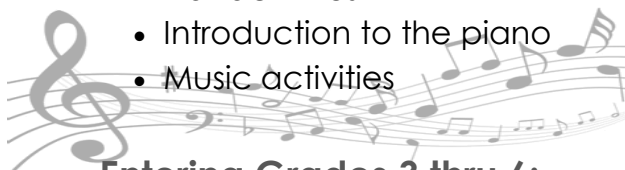
Classes will be held in the Education Wing located on the lower level, north end of the church.

Entering Grades 4 thru 6:

Mr. Longfield will meet with each child before sessions begin to evaluate physical characteristics for the instrument selected.

clarinet, flute, saxophone
cornet/trumpet, trombone

Entering Grades 5 thru 8:

A community band & string program for those who have completed:

- Grade 6 school music program
- *MusicStart* 2018 or
- At least one year of private study

If there is a question about eligibility, students will be interviewed by the Director.

Music training which is presented in a positive and affirming manner benefits children artistically, socially, and academically. At this time children who are younger than grade six are not offered instrumental music instruction in Prescott area schools. However children younger than grade six have the ability to play an instrument; and, an earlier start in this experience is beneficial both to the child, the schools and to the community at large.

As a church with a rich music heritage and a congregation which places a high value on excellence in music, we believe that offering this program will provide an earlier exposure to music which can influence the future of music within churches, community, and school systems.

This program is open to any child in our community. Group instruction for **MusicStart** in band/strings will continue once a week during the 2019-20 school year.
